Job Description

Forage areas of focus: inoculant management, harvest quality, and product offerings • Manage forage inoculate inventories while monitoring in-field inoculant application practices.

- Work with farm management & outside technical services to assess key harvest quality benchmarks.
- Develop foundational knowledge of forage production practices and product offerings (silage coverings, inoculants, bags, etc.)

PRINCIPAL DUTIES OF POSITION

Assist farm with monitoring harvest progress and production metrics. • Responsible for forage inoculate application during harvest.

- provide training on product storage, mixing procedures, application rates, and in-field inventory management
- $\circ\;$ daily reconciliation of inoculant usage to harvested tons
- work with field technicians to provide ongoing operational feedback for improvements
- Collect and analyze corn silage samples from the bunk and the field.
 - $\circ~$ assess kernel processing score (KPS) using mobile lab
 - evaluate chopper processing characteristics (chop length, dry matters, etc.)
 - communicate sample results across organization and coordinate in-field adjustments to choppers
- Assist with compilation of harvest results and analyses tracking across google workspace applications for real time dissemination.
 - Organize observations into a formal presentation assessing collected data.



AS AN INTERN YOU WILL

- Approximately half of the internship will be working in the field with farm & custom harvester personnel.
- Requires strong communication skills and the ability to coordinate with farm management and custom harvesters exercising influence to achieve harvest production goals.
- During harvest, work weeks will be 70+ hours and require weekend availability. May require independent travel in Florida and Georgia.
- Position will gain a broad understanding of Suwannee Valley Feeds' mill operations.
